Re: EUR-ACE® Framework Standards and Guidelines (EAFSG)

Dear ENAAEE Partner, dear Sir,

At its meeting held in June 2014, the ENAAEE Administrative Council agreed on a process for the revision of the EUR-ACE Framework Standards. The main motivation for this was that after eight years of use and more than 1800 EUR-ACE® labels awarded, the time had come for a review and revision, not by changing the standards but to take into account feedback from ENAAEE stakeholders and to clarify and simplify the presentation.

A Working Group was set up; after almost one year of work, it has proposed its recommendations to the Administrative Council. On March 31, the ENAAEE AC approved the new version of the EUR-ACE® Framework Standards and Guidelines (EAFSG) which are consequently published and are available in the ENAAEE website (see <http://www.enaee.eu/eur-ace-system/>). They are defined in terms of

- (a) Standards and Guidelines for Accreditation of Engineering Programmes.
- (b) Standards and Guidelines for Accreditation Agencies.

The different sections may be consulted electronically; the full document may be accessed under "Documents" on our website and downloaded as a pdf printable file.

A synthesised PowerPoint presentation is also available at the ENAAEE web-link (<http://www.enaee.eu/eur-ace-system/eur-ace-framework-standards-and-guidelines>), and within a few weeks, a presentation leaflet will also be available there. The ENAAEE authorised agencies are being asked to translate the EAFSG into their national languages for better dissemination; these communication documents will be available on the ENAAEE website. However, the English language version will remain the only official reference text.

The ENAAEE Administrative Council encourages your institution to disseminate the revised EAFSG within your membership. They provide the up-to-date education requirements for graduates to enter the engineering profession and to have their qualifications recognised throughout Europe and beyond.

Your feedback on this document would be appreciated and we remain at your disposal for further exchanges.
