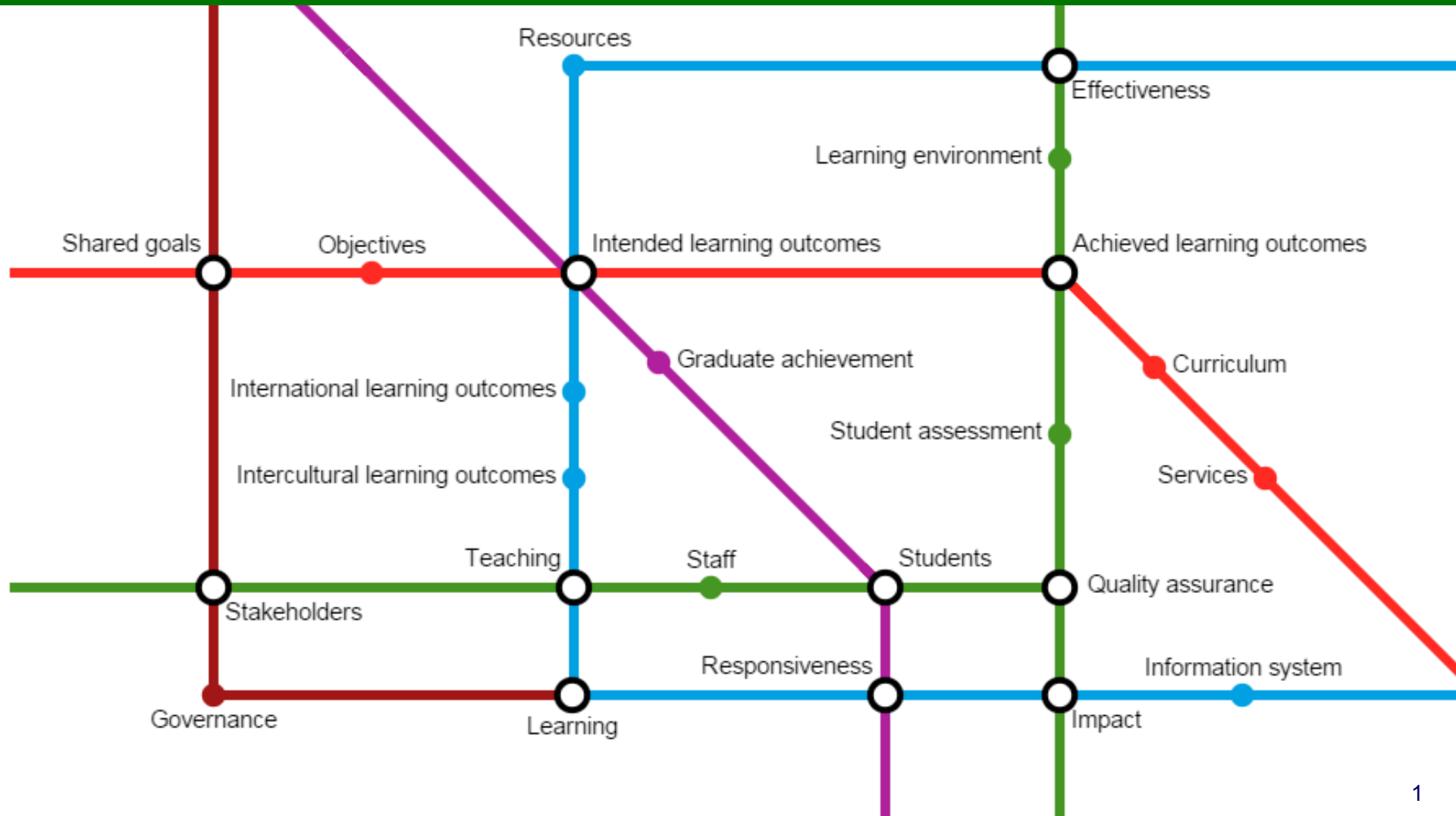

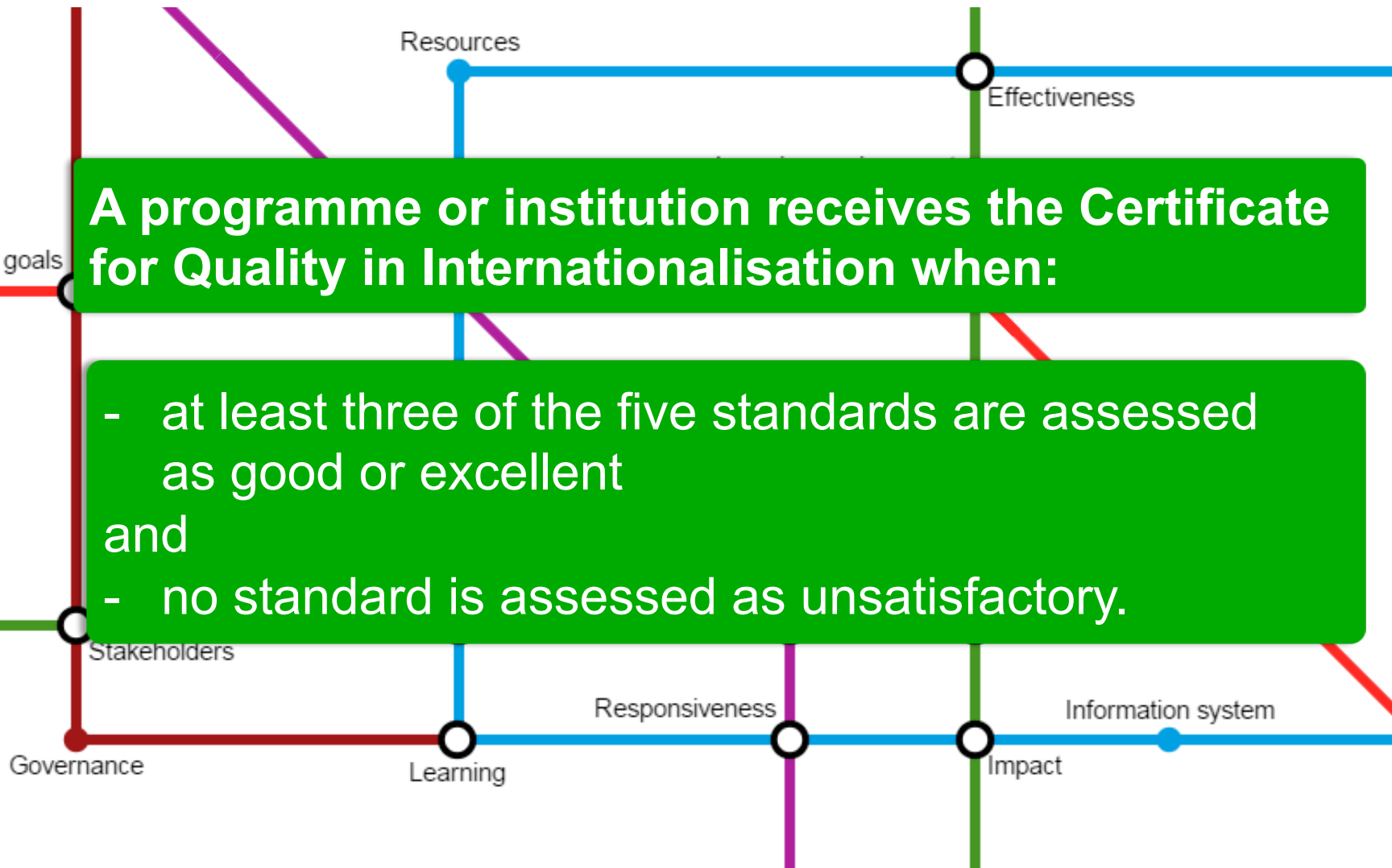


The Certificate for Quality in internationalisation

A programme or institution receives the Certificate for Quality in Internationalisation when:

- at least three of the five standards are assessed as good or excellent and
- no standard is assessed as unsatisfactory.

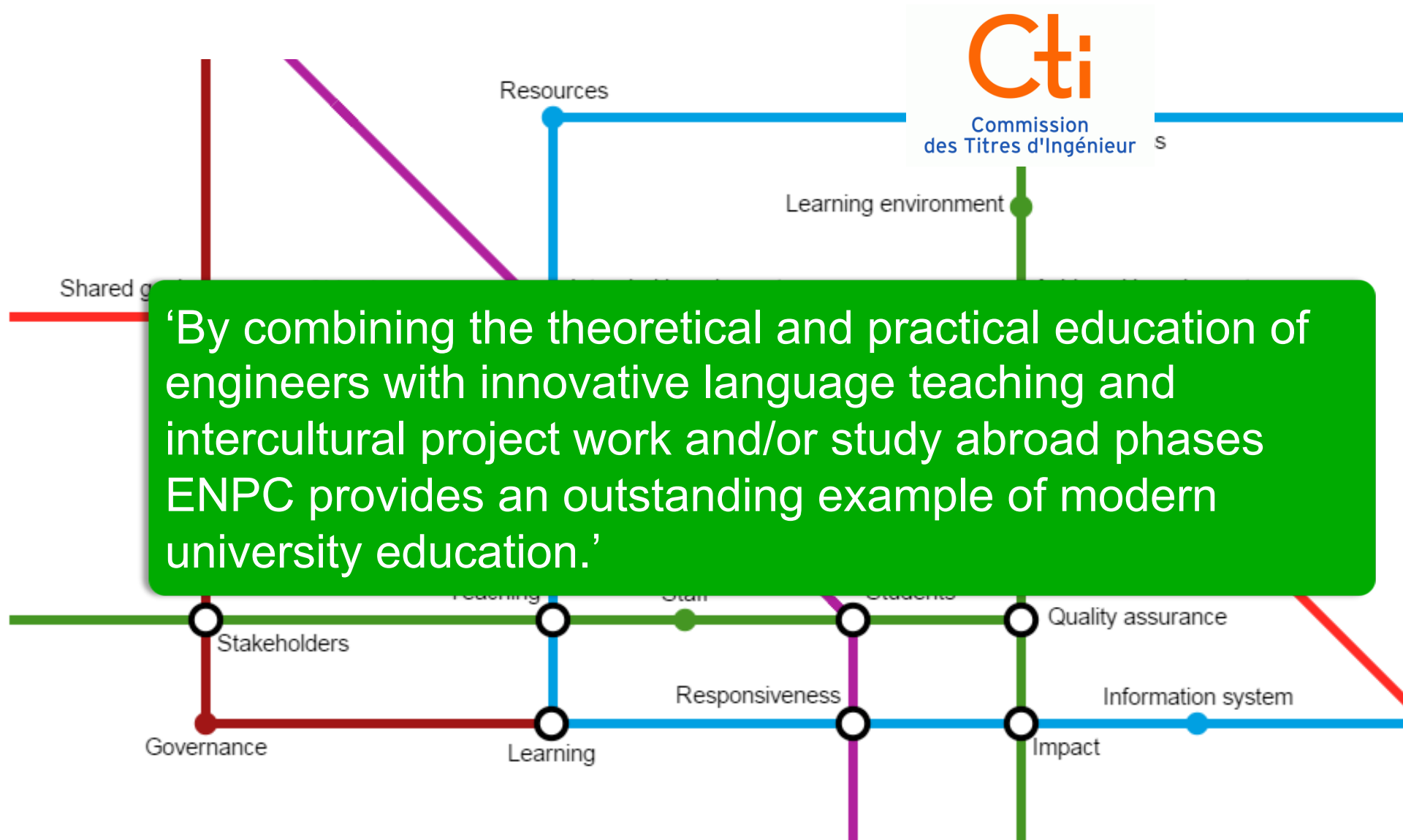
