- External QA difficult / challenging
- Mainly national sources of information
- JOQAR Project => Coordination point
- Feasibility study (50 JP from more than 30 countries, 19 QA agencies from 17 countries)
- Strong demand
- Coordinated European approach
- Direct response to the European Commission report on progress in QA in HE (September 2009)





European Commission progress report:Stronger European dimension in QA in Higher Education

"National quality assurance agencies should be encouraged to develop activities beyond their borders and to seek the recognition of their decisions in other countries, e.g. through conventions of mutual recognition. [...] There may be a need to clarify the portability of national accreditation within the EHEA and also the issue of



quality assurance for cross-border higher education within the EHEA. Given the growing importance of joint and double degree courses in Europe, clear principles might be useful to avoid the need for multiple accreditations"

Coordination of Single Accreditation Procedures

- Advice and support to JP and QA agencies
- Methodology
- Exchange of good practices
- Trainings of experts

- Assist the process
- 3 phases: Orientation, Assessment, Decision-Making





Orientation Phase

Provision of information:

Coordination Point (Online services)

Pre-existing MULTRA accreditation(s):

- If yes, MULTRA recognition route
- If not, is mutual recognition possible?

Mutual Recognition:

- If possible > selection of the coordinating agency
 - Joint Programme consortium
 - Involved national agencies
 - Coordination Point





Assessment Phase

Self-Evaluation Report:

Prepared by the JP consortium

Nomination of the Experts and Observers for the panel:

- Coordination agency
- Involved national Agencies
- Coordination Point (Pool of Experts)

The site visit:

- Organised by the coordinated agency
- Realised by the panel

The assesment report by the panel:

Received by the Coordinating Agency





Decision-Making Phase

Accreditation Decision:

- Taken by the coordinating agency
- Coordination Point supports the recognition by all involved agencies
- Publication of decisions
- Inclusion of the JP into Qrossroads

Appeal:

- The JP consortium does not accept the decision
- Coordination Point organises an appeal procedure by a European Appeals Committee Coordination Point supports the recognition by all involved agencies
