- HE institutions want to work with one contact
- As an informal body, the CP can “support”
- The CP needs to provide the necessary information
  - Guide
- Conflict of interest CP, ECA, agencies
- Online information CP
  - part of ECA

# How could the services of the CP be promoted?

- Embedding in existing structures helps to promote
- Use existing structures
- National structures
  - Agencies offer information and organise/take part in meetings for existing JPs and JPs under development
  - JP workshops, symposia

# How could the activities of the CP be financed?

- European Commission

- JP consortia for use of single accreditation procedure
