Joint Programmes (JP) in the EHEA 2013

- JPs are on top of the European HE-agenda
- > 150 Erasmus Mundus master programmes
- Estimated total number of JPs: > 2500
- Obstacles for HEIs in organizing JPs
- Multiple problems with recognition of qualifications awarded by JPs
- Challenges in the Accreditation/QA of JPs

Joint programme - Definition

Joint programme: "A higher education curriculum coordinated among different HEIs, offered jointly by these institutions and leading to a (joint or multiple) degree"

Joint degree: "A single document awared by HEIs offering the joint programme, nationally acknowledged as the recognized award of the joint programme"



Joint and multiple degrees - Definitions


Multiple degree: "Separate degrees awared by HEIs offering the joint programme attesting the successful completion of this programme"

 Dual degree: "Two degrees awarded by HEIs individually, attesting successful completion of two separate curricula"


