

Unibasq and AQAS approach

Conclusion: Existing formats do not meet the

requirements

- Specific training
- Target groups: academics and students
- Language: Spanish and German

Separate trainings

- 2 pilots:
 - One in German held in the Basque Country
 - One in Spanish held in Germany

10 – 15 people, proficient in the required language2 day training

Content of the training

- The agency and the specific HES
- Memorandum of understanding of Unibasq and AQAS
- The specific accreditation system
- Review procedure
- Evaluation criteria
- Roles and responsibilities (Experts and coordinator)
- Writing the report
- Outlook and practicalities (ESG 2015)

Experiences

- Training for German speaking experts (11) held in Bilbao
- Training went much smoother then expected
- All experts agreed to share CV's
- Currently: inclusion of experts in AQAS procedures (3-4)
- Training for Spanish speaking experts in Cologne in October
- Work in progress....

Hopes and expectations

- Increase the number of foreign experts in our regular procedures
- Create the environment for the equal participation of foreign experts
- Create opportunities for collaboration between the two HES
