 - Check-list for joint programmes

Extension of Qrossroads

- New version functional
 - Clear and efficient
 - horizontal separations for the sections "programmes", "institutions", "countries"
- Clear interface organised in tabs
- New search function
 - Easy and faithful
- Not regularly updated by the agencies:
 - Frequency
 - CTI updates daily
 - PKA once a month
 - ANECA will update end 2014
 - A3ES will consider joining
 - Obstacles
 - ECA secretariat can help

- Part of the CeQuInt project
- Objectives:
 - Publish awarded certificates
 - Publish identified good practices
- Source of inspiration: texts, images, links
- Integration into visual identity of the existing portal
- Online submission system
- Should correspond to one of the standards of the CeQuInt framework
- Evaluation by independent experts (certificate procedure or independent)
- WG3 members will actively contribute and will put a link on their webpages
- a clearer formulation of expectations, responsibilities and a clear tasks division
- Not relevant before the establishing of the certificate
