The session is interactive and the input from participants is welcomed and expected. Participants will share their experience on QA of Internationalisation at the institutional & Programme Level.

#### 14.00 – 15.30 QUALITY ASSURANCE AND INTERNATIONALISATION

The relationship between quality and internationalization has two dimensions: it addresses the quality of internalization processes & practices, and the contribution of internationalisation to the quality of education and research. For a long time, the first dimension was assessed with a quantitative approach, making extensive use of indicators such as the number of cooperation agreements, the number of internationally co-authored publications etc. On the one hand, it leaves out the contribution of internationalisation to the HEI's nonmobile population (still the vast majority in most HEIs) and on the other

hand, it tends to reduce the focus of assessment on outputs. Nevertheless, initiatives such as CeQuint has demonstrated a shift from a purely output approach to a more inclusive approach of QA, taking into account intended international and intercultural outcome. How have agencies, universities and governments integrated internationalisation into their evaluation and accreditation processes? Do the many existing tools and labels complement or compete with each other? What lessons can be learned for the quality assurance of the European University Alliances?
